Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 12:00pm Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 15/11/2021.

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Organisation's rules prior to lodging nominations.

Candidate Statements

Candidates may submit a written statement of no more than 150 words containing his or her Association and employment/professional history and place of employment and may include a photograph to be included with the ballot material.

Only statements and photographs which comply with the Rules and are received by the Returning Officer by 12:00pm (Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT)) on 10/11/2021 can be accepted.

Candidate statements should be submitted as a word document and photographs in jpeg format.
