Lodging Nominations

Nominations open on Wednesday 1 October 2025 and must reach the Returning Officer, Chris King **not later than** 12 midday Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on Friday 17 October 2025.

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 12 midday AEDT on Wednesday 22 October 2025.

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Organisation's rules prior to lodging nominations.

Nominations, Candidate Statements and Photographs must be lodged via the following method:

By Email: A properly completed nomination form including all necessary signatures and attachments may be scanned and submitted as a pdf file to IEBnominations@aec.gov.au

Candidate Statements

Candidates may submit a separate statement to be included with ballot material. Only statements and photographs which comply with the Rules and are received by the Returning Officer by 12 midday AEDT on Friday 17 October 2025 can be accepted.

Submitted Candidate Statements should contain:

- The Candidate's Association and employment/professional history and place of employment,
- a photograph, and
- a **maximum of 150 words**.

Candidate statements should be submitted in a recognised Word format (for example, .docx) and photographs in format such as .jpeg.

Scrutineer Appointment

The appointment of scrutineers opens 10:00am Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on Wednesday 1 October 2025 and closes 10am (AEDT) on Wednesday 17 December 2025.
