



Offshore TV Minimum Rates and Allowances

Offshore TV minimum rates updated from 1 July 2022

Offshore TV agreements are negotiated between producers and MEAA for each individual production. The minimum rates are higher than MPPA minimums.

Every offshore TV agreement includes a provision that the minimum rates will increase in line with the increase to the minimum wage. Increase for 1 July 2022 is 4.6%.

Allowances updated from 1 Jan 2022

These allowances are in effect from 1 January 2022. All crew agreements use MPPA allowances as agreed with Screen Producers Australia, adjusted each year in line with the change in the relevant CPI category for the preceding 12 months.

TRAVELLING ALLOWANCES

Where an employee receives the minimum rate of pay and agrees to provide their own transport between the Employer's usual place of business and a location within the 20 km radius: \$9.00 per day

Where an employee receives the minimum rate of pay and is required to drive a vehicle more than two tonnes tare: \$6.24 per day
