Remembering the fallen

As part of the former Gona Barracks, Parer Place has historic associations with the despatch of troops to both the first and second world wars. The new QUT Creative Industries Precinct development, which sensitively integrates the repurposed Defence Reserve structures, is a fitting location for a memorial to mark the centenary of World War I.

The memorial will not only commemorate fallen service men and women across all campaigns, but also pay tribute to the many media workers tragically killed during war. The site was named in honour of Damien Parer, the celebrated cameraman killed in the Pacific Islands campaign, and QUT's commitment to training future film and television staff and journalists continues on the site today.
