Small World is a drama anthology series showcasing the small daily struggles that people from marginalised communities experience, highlighting the importance of chosen family: the people that lend us strength and help keep us afloat when we feel isolated in our experience of the world.

Set amongst the hills of small town Australia, this anthology series takes us into the stories of seven young people navigating their lives amidst the unique social issues that their identities present.

We meet a refugee, trying his best to fit in, a trans man grappling with dysphoria, a young mother and the poverty trap, a wheelchair wielding man navigating a town not built for wheels, a businesswoman enduring her work's sexist corporate culture, a tradie struggling with his mental health, a woman confronting internalised shame about her sexuality, and see the smalls ways in which all their stories are connected.

This is an observational, non-preachy window into the daily lives of ordinary people. It's a series about the small things that wear us down, and the people that help bring us back up.

Based on the authentic stories and insights of real people, the series provides a window into the lives of various marginalised communities and contemporary social issues; creating a realistic portrait of small town Australia and the people that live, work, and struggle here.
