- Does the agent charge upfront or any sort of on-going fees? How much are they and what will the fees cover? Check what expenses/charges you may be expected to meet.
- Is there a contract that the agent wants you to sign?

You may want to ask some of the following questions:

- How will you promote me?
- How will you get me work?
- How many clients do you have?
- What films / television shows / commercials / theatre have your clients done recently?
- (if extras agent) For what films / television shows / (commercials) have you provided extras?
