### 5) "FIRST LIGHT" by KATE GERAGHTY

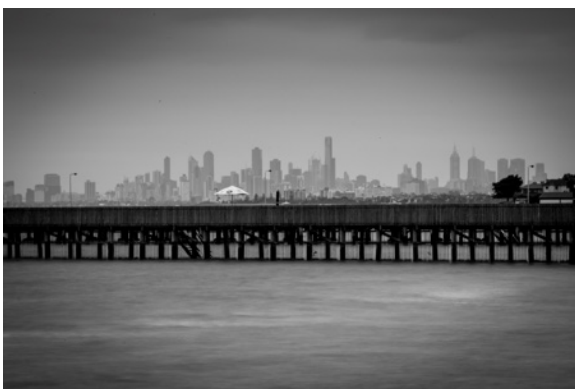


Swimmers take to the water at Clovelly Beach at sunrise before the temperatures are set to soar on another hot Sydney summer day - 24th January, 2017

### 7) "STORM FRONT ON BONDI BEACH" by ROHAN KELLY

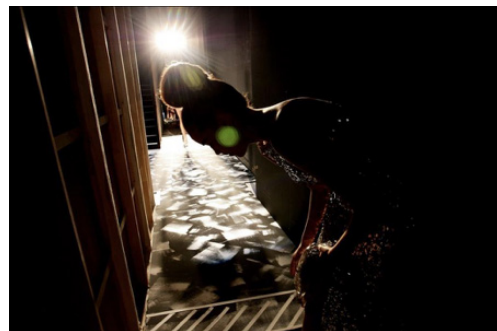

Although there were many other photographers in the area, capturing a girl in her bikini reading her iPad, unaware of the storm above, made his image stand out from the crowd and has become an example and metaphor for our attitude to climate change. Kelly's photo was published around the country and picked up overseas creating headlines around the world. It went onto win first prize (nature) at the World Press Photo Awards in 2016.

Rohan Kelly grew up on a farm in Western Australia before moving to Darwin for his first photography job in 1998 at the *Northern Territory News* in Darwin. He covered the 2000 Sydney Olympics as part of the News Corp national team of photographers and was a Nikon-Walkley finalist for his sports pictures. In 2001, he moved to Sydney to work at *The Daily Telegraph* and has since worked across all sections of the paper.

## 9) "GUST FRONT 1" by NICK MOIR



Nick Moir travelled to the USA to continue a lifelong body of work on weather dynamics and phenomena. While tornadoes gain the most attention in the USA because of their ferocity and the destruction they cause, the momentous scale of a "shelf cloud" often accompanied by very strong winds, flash flooding and huge hail also creates havoc on the roads, towns and cities it covers. For a storm chaser, they are avoided as getting stuck in one brings visibility down and introduces the danger of driving into a flash flood.

Moir's passion is capturing the dramatic environmental phenomena of Australia, from its ragged lightning and dust storms and blackening bushfires to the devastating effects of climate change. He received a World Press Photo award for coverage of the destructive 2002-03 bushfire season and was named Nikon-Walkley Press Photographer in 2002 for a series on Sydney's severe weather. He works for *The Sydney Morning Herald* and is a founding member of Oculi.

## 10) "HELMAND FRONTLINE" by ANDREW QUILTY



Afghan National Policemen rest inside an isolated checkpoint less than 100m from a compound under Taliban control in Chah-e Anjir, Helmand Province. Since this photo was taken, the Taliban have taken over the outpost and surrounding area.

Andrew Quilty was the 2016 Gold Walkley Award Winner and is a former Nikon-Walkley Press Photographer of the Year. Since 2013 he has been based in Kabul as a freelance photojournalist, relentlessly pursuing the complex and important stories in a country that — after some 14 years of war — may have receded from the world's front pages, but is no less dangerous or critical. Since moving to Afghanistan, Quilty has won six Walkley Awards. In 2016, he won the prestigious Polk Award for photojournalism and a Picture of the Year International award. Most recently, Quilty's work from Afghanistan was exhibited at the world's premier festival for photojournalism, Visa Pour L'Image, in Perpignan, France.

## 13) "FAIRY POOLS" by JAMES VODICKA

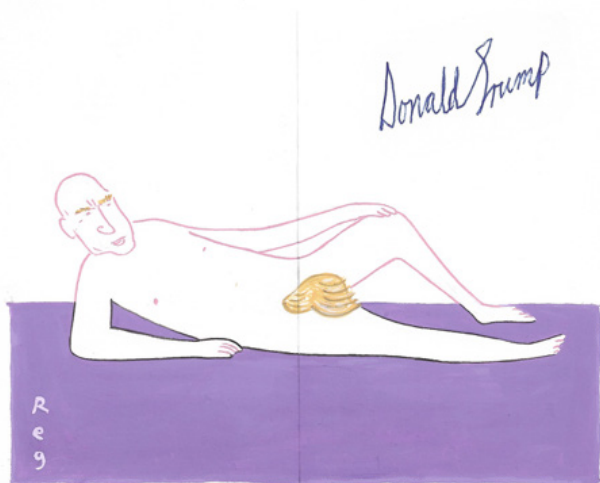

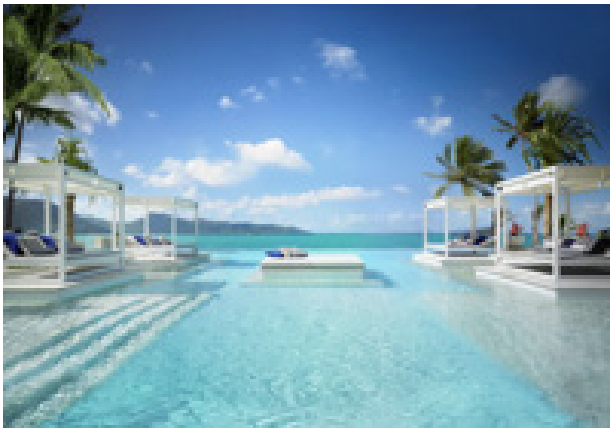

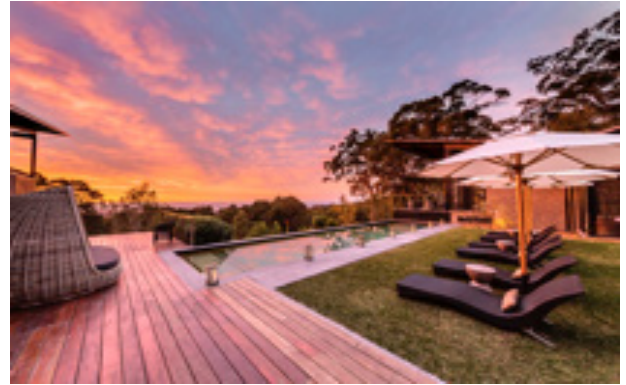
