## KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

### January 2015

Recognising that the Internet of Things (IOT) was set to become an area of great interest and activity in the IT industry I launched Australia's first news site dedicated to the topic ([www.iotaustralia.org.au](http://www.iotaustralia.org.au)).

### January 2009

I launched a daily newsletter for the Australian telecommunications industry and until I resigned the role at the end of August 2012 I was almost solely responsible for researching, writing, producing and distributing this publication. Content came from many sources: interviews, conferences and seminars, press conferences, press releases, government publications, white papers etc. From these sources I produced a newsletter of, generally, between four and six pages which I distributed via email at 8.30 am each business day.

### September 2005

I co-founded a web site ([www.itwire.com](http://www.itwire.com)) to deliver news and other content to Australian information technology and telecommunications professionals. My main role was as the telecommunications editor. I was also a director until July 2012 and I remain a shareholder.

### April 1989

I founded 3rd Wave Communication Pty Ltd to publish a weekly subscription newsletter, *Exchange*, for the Australian telecommunications industry. *Exchange* was followed in 1993 by *ExchangeAsia* covering telecommunications developments throughout Asia.

I edited and oversaw production of both publications, providing quality control of content and formatting and ensuring consistent on-time production and distribution until *Exchange* was converted into a daily newsletter in 2009 and *ExchangeAsia* ceased publication at the end of 2011.
